TRAINS COMING HERE IN MIDDLE OF JUNE

SALMON, Ore., March 27—(U.P.)—For the first time since the world war troops of the Oregon National Guard will train entirely within the state boundaries when the annual summer encampments are established next June.

Eight trains will be needed to move the troops, according to arrangements made with railroad companies. Seven of the trains will transport troops to Camp Jackson, near Medford, where training will begin June 15. Another train will transport the coast artillery to forts at the mouth of the Columbia river.

Cities which will send troops to camp are: Portland, Salem, Eugene, McMinnville, Roseburg, Oregon City, St. Helens, Silverton, Tillamook, Dallas, Corvallis, Woodburn, Gresham, Medford, Grants Pass, Cottage Grove, La Grande, Baker, Astoria, The Dalles, Forest Grove, Albany, Ashland, Marshfield, Newport, Toledo, Lebanon, Union and Springfield.
