As its contribution towards the solution of the probservice, the Radio Corporation of America has erected an experimental, powerful broadcasting station at Bound Brook, N. J. Its aim is to demonstrate the utility of superpower transmission in radio broadcasting and to determine to what extent a system of superpower stations, joined by wire or eventually connected by radio relay, would meet the need of a nation-wide service.

Definite conclusions developed from broadcasting tests of this station cannot yet be announced, but evidence produced by 50,000 letters received by the Radio Corporation from listeners-in indicate that these experimental demonstrations of superpower broadcasting have been extraordinarity successful-


