SURVIVOR OF CRASH TAKEN TO HOME IN VANCOUVER

VANCOUVER, Wash., April 23. — C. B. Archer, injured in an accident on the Columbia Highway near Viento, Wednesday when a truck in which he was riding catapulted into a creek, and his companion was killed, lives at No. 1717 Broadway, this city, and was being brought here Wednesday night by officials of the Royal Baking company.

Archer suffered cuts on his right arm and right leg and under his eye, in addition to severe bruises. He said he was dozing at the time the accident occurred and knew none of the details. He will probably be confined to his home for several weeks. He is married and has been in the employ of the Portland company since August.

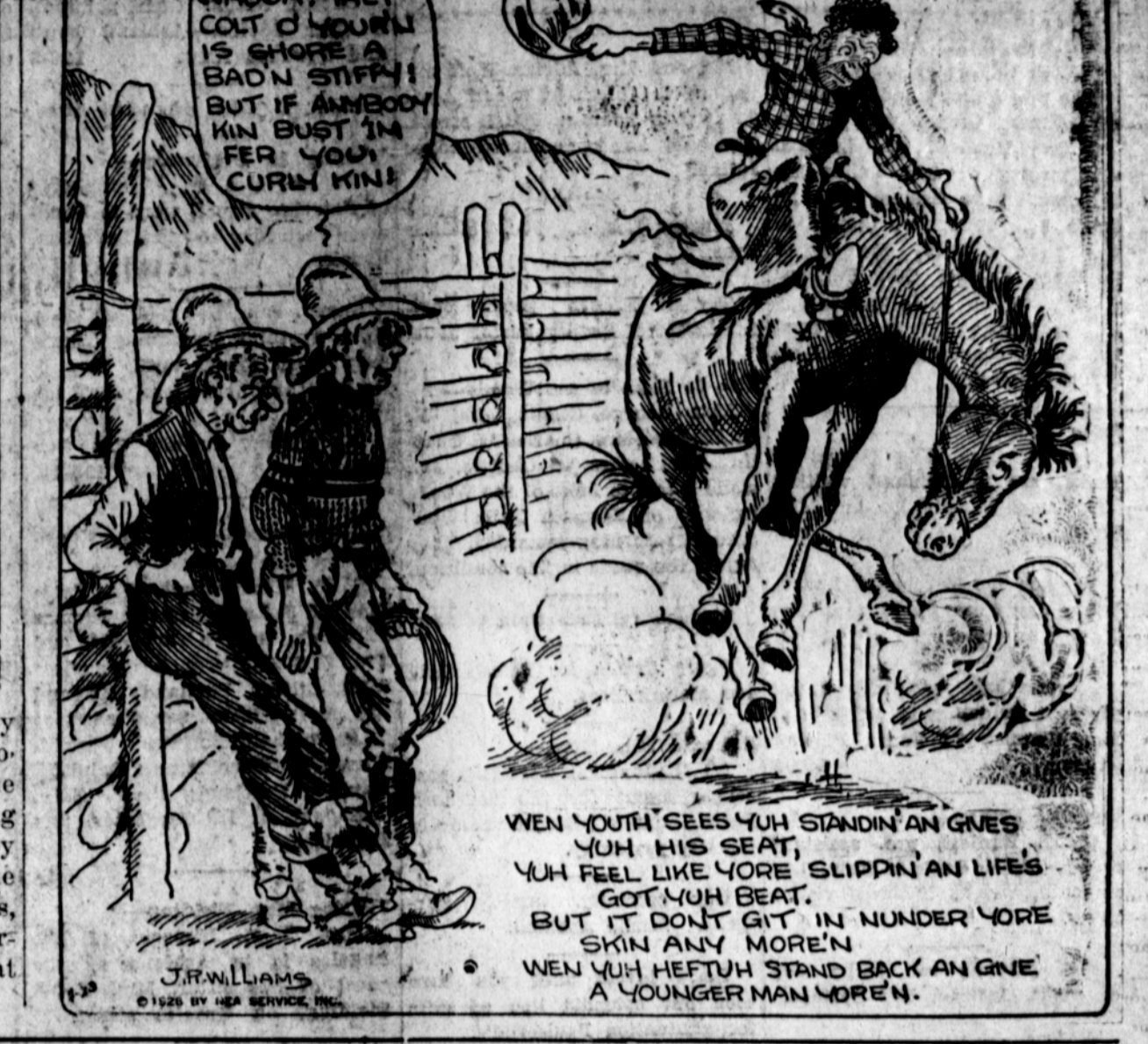
