YACHTING POPULAR IN SAN FRANCISCO

SAN FRANCISCO, April 27.—(UP)—While sail are becoming increasingly numerous on the bay, the season of warm but brisk breezes has arrived and yachtsmen are stretching their muscles luxuriously.

The yachting season officially opens in two weeks or so. Many new boats will be seen in San Francisco waters, as well as in yachting centers farther down the coast, the season.

Yachtsmen are displaying interest keenly in the coming yachting events, chief of which will be the fourth annual regatta of the Pacific Coast Yachting association to be held on San Francisco Bay August 31 to September 1.

Yachts from all parts of the Pacific coast will be brought here for these races. At least three star class boats will come from Honolulu to compete against mainland craft. These boats, together with several coast boats, will be transported by steamer to New York after the events here are completed to sail in the annual regatta of the International Star Boat association at Long Island.

Among the new boats coming to San Francisco bay will be an 85-foot schooner, now being built on the Atlantic coast for Captain A. L. Norris, of the San Francisco Yacht club. The boat will embody the latest features in schooner construction and will be, it is expected, one of the finest craft of her kind to ever come to Pacific waters.

Captain Norris is building the new boat to replace his old schooner, the Mariner, which he recently sold to John Barrymore, Hollywood stage and screen star, and enthusiastic yachtsman.

Considerable interest has been aroused here over reports that a number of wealthy Pebble Beach residents are planning to purchase an entire fleet of sail boats of the same design for racing on Monterey bay.

Jazz Now Played In Sunny Hawaii

SAN FRANCISCO, April 27.—(UP)—Hawaii's fringed wave-lapped shores have changed. No longer does the night breeze carry the lulling sound of grass skirts, swishing rhythmically to the ukelele chords of "Yaki hula hula hula."

No longer are the stranger's eyes entranced by the gently swaying forms of the Hawaiian dancing girls, doing the hula in the warm path of the full tropic moon.

Instead, Hawaii's on-romantic nights are disturbed by the raucous notes of the American jazz hall—the unnerving strains of "Yessir That's M'baby"—and the native shrieks of "Hey! Hey!"

Hawaii, having well-nigh exhausted the possibilities of the hula, is doing the Charleston. The hula is performed only when strangers insist, and the next generation, probably, won't know anything about it.

Such was the disgusting statement brought to San Francisco by Miss Julia Marquise, daughter of a wealthy planter near Honolulu, and a descendant of an old royal family of Hawaii.
