COSTS TOO MUCH TO DIE IN MOSCOW NOW

MOSCOW, (UP)—The Moscow Soviet has placed a premium on living, at least for private traders and businessmen, by raising the charge for graves in the municipal cemeteries from ten to twenty-five dollars.

Class distinction does not stop at the grave in Moscow. Workers and employees belonging to trade unions are only obliged to pay fifty cents for their burial places, just as they are charged relatively low rents for their rooms. Professional people, doctors, lawyers, etc., pay \$2.50 for their graves; and the rate for the harassed trader has now been put up to twenty-five dollars.

The funeral department of the Moscow municipality has been running at a loss, estimated at a penny to every grave. In order to overcome this deficit the new charge has been imposed upon the business men.

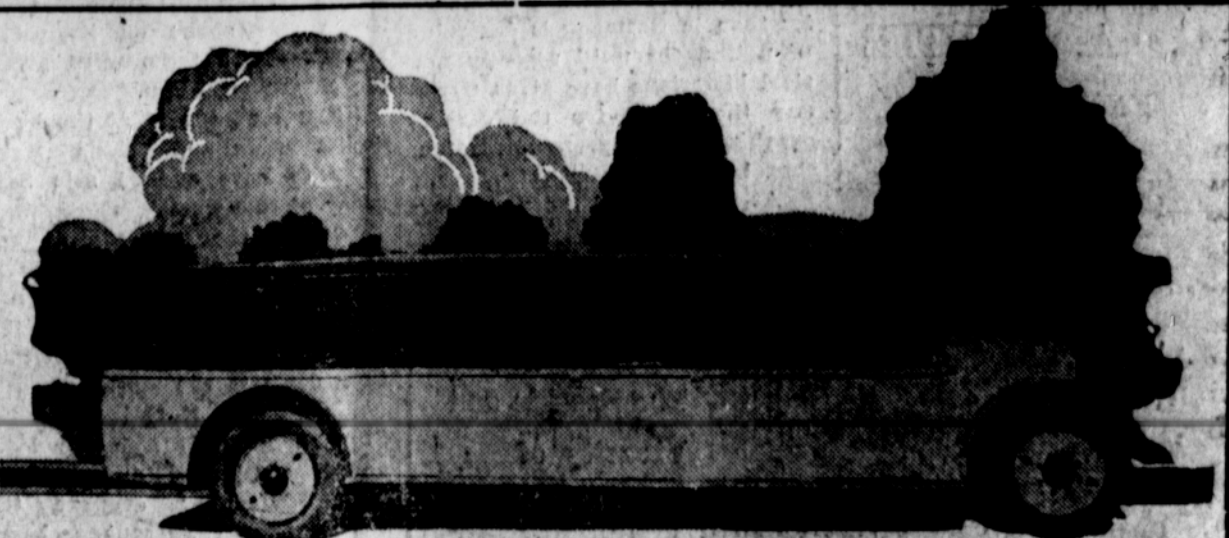

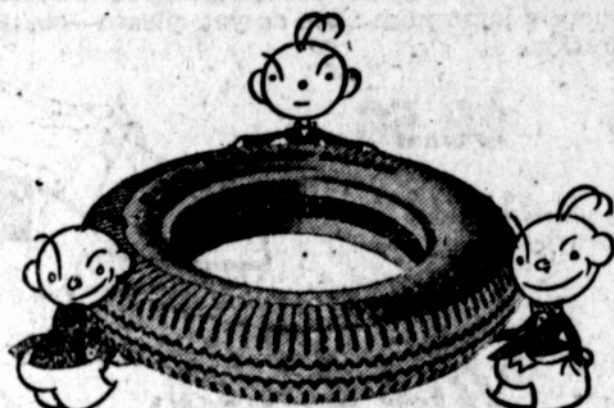

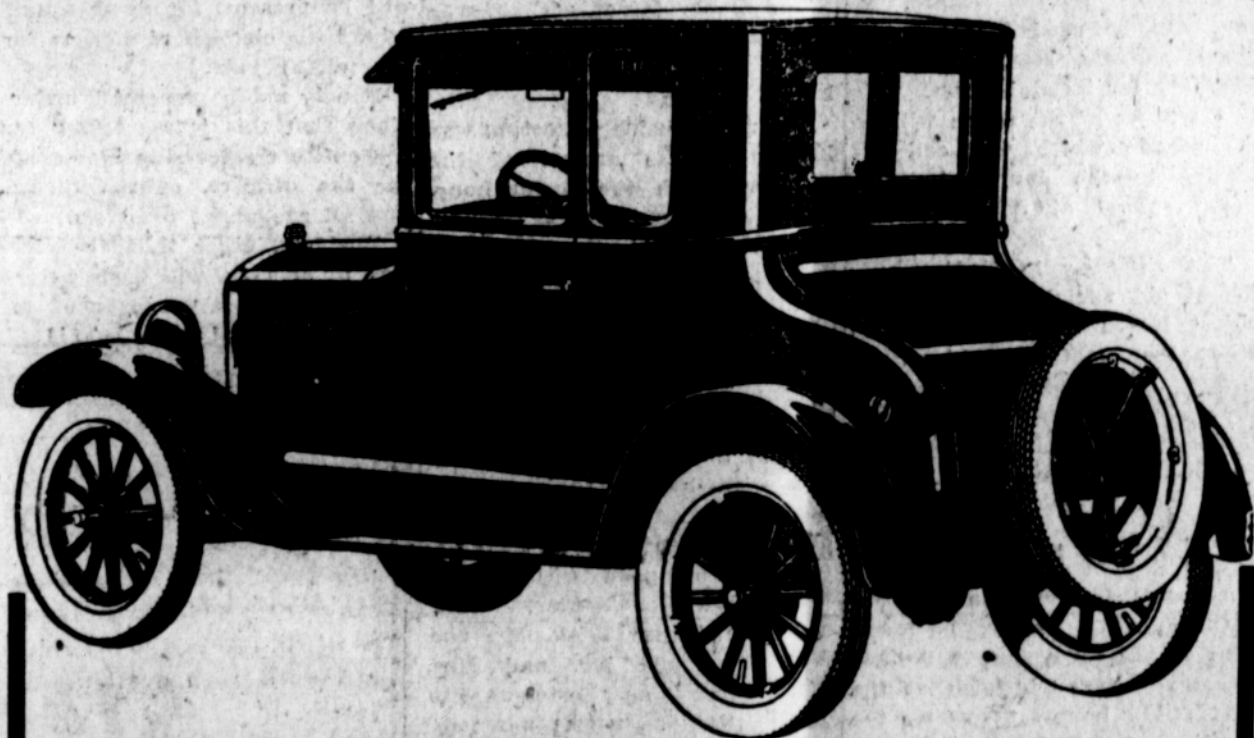
