VALUABLE CHINESE RELICS ARE GIVEN
SAN FRANCISCO, May 11.—(UP)—Rare and priceless archaeological relics from ancient Chinese dynasties—Tang, Sung, and Ming—have been added to the M. H. De Young museum at Golden Gate park.

The authenticity of the pieces is without question, as the commissioners of the Frederick Tabor estate, who purchased the collection, have made careful investigation.

The tomb pieces, which include graceful and elaborately turned vases of the periods, hundreds of years before Christ, were removed when the first Chinese railways—the Woosung, in 1876, and the Tien Tsui, in 1896,—were laid.

Many ancient tombs were cut through by the railroads, and the relics, deposited by filial devotion, according to the custom of the day, were seized by the collectors under imperial protest. Later they were released, but after much red tape. They throw light on the high degree of artistic development in China before the Christian era.
