

EPISCOPAL CHURCH IS NOW COMPLETELY OUT OF DEBT

RACINE, Wis., May 19.—(UP)—The Episcopal Church is free of debt and in the most favorable financial condition since 1919. Louis B. Franklin, Vice President and Treasurer of the National Council of the Episcopal Church, reported at the opening session of the Spring meeting of the Council. As a consequence of the funds which have been contributed since October last by the dioceses throughout the country to extinguish a deficit of \$1,500,000 "outside of money borrowed from our reserve deposit accounts in the sum of \$705, we don't owe a penny to anybody," Franklin told the Council.

The "reserve deposit accounts" are special funds available for use by the Missionary Society, in effect, the Church itself, at such times as its income may be less

than its expenditures, with a provision that money thus borrowed must be repaid as soon as possible. The Episcopal Church, therefore, according to Franklin's report, is free of debt, except to itself through its reserve deposit accounts. This is the first time, Franklin declared, that the Church has been in such a favorable financial condition since 1919. He stressed, however, the importance of restoring the reserve deposit accounts without delay.

A highly favorable report on the position of the Church in Mexico was made to the Council by Dr. John W. Wood, Executive Secretary of the Department of Missions. Bishop Creighton, who was recently dispatched to look after the Church's interests here, has reported that he has

been assured of the kindly intentions of the Mexican Government towards the Church. An improved situation in China was also reported by Dr. Wood. A Chinese Commission appointed to dispose of the Excess Fund returned to China by the United States has notified the officials of Boone University, the Episcopal institution in the District of Hankow, of an award of \$10,000 annually for the year of the support of the Library School, the only school in China for the training of librarians.

The tentative plan is to add a flat license fee of not less than \$3.00, or more than \$10.00, on all cars, and a property tax of not more than 70 per cent on the value of new cars and gradually reduced to a flat assessed value from the fourth year on of 10 or 20 per cent.

CONVERT YOUR INSURANCE URGES VETERANS BUREAU

WASHINGTON, May 18.—(UP)—General Frank T. Hines has issued a warning to the 3,500,000 world war veterans who have not taken advantage of making application for reinsurance that all claims must be filed before July 2 to be valid. There has been 29,499 applications for government life insurance totaling about \$160,000,000 filed since January 1, General Hines, Director of the Veterans Bureau announced. Each policy averages about \$5,400 per vet-
