

To Consecrate New Cathedral

LOS ANGELES, May 19.—Archbishop Edward H. Hanna, San Francisco, will be the consecrator at the 50th anniversary of the Cathedral of Vibiana here May 25. A solemn pontifical high mass will be celebrated by the Rt. Rev. J. J. Cantwell, bishop of the diocese of Los Angeles and San Diego. Announcement of the special services was made by John Crowley, rector of the cathedral.

BERLIN BARS "LOCARNO" AS TRADE-MARK FOR NETS

BERLIN (UP)—Suspicion that an unheeded slur against the Locarno policy was intended, has caused the German patent office to prohibit a prominent net manufacturing company from adopting "Locarno" as a trade-mark. It was suggested that the use of this name might be construed as meaning that Germany was enticed into the Allies' net at Locarno. Another ban was imposed by the patent office when permission was refused to an underwear manufacturing concern, which wished to employ the word "Decency" as its trade-mark on undergarment. Evidently suggestive of indecency.

Whereas said pictures have been officially designated "On Flanders Field," and the funds received from the exhibition at the Vining theatre in this city on May 26th and 27th. The funds are to be used by the veterans in carrying on their meritorious work, and

Therefore, I, O. H. Johnson, Mayor of Ashland, in order to draw special films, and the worthy purposes for which they are shown, do earnestly request the citizens of Ashland to promote the patriotic purposes of this exhibition, and urge the merchants and business houses to

An Old Story With a New Application

SOLDIERS AND SAILORS

Senator Stanfield at all times has been the friend, supporter and defender of the American soldier and sailor. Some of the finest things that have ever been said about the Spanish-American war veterans were written by Senator Stanfield in a story entitled "The One Hundred Days' War," and appearing in the New Age, a Masonic magazine published in Washington, D. C. The following is quoted from the closing paragraphs:

"Time has mellowed the lives and broadened the vision of the veterans of the Spanish-American war. They know what responsibility means, and they know what it is to serve and to give the last full measure of devotion." Senator Stanfield, standing by his pledge made in 1920 to the ex-service men was a fine example of standing by your colors under fire.

PROHIBITION

For years Senator Stanfield has been a consistent and effective foe of the commercialized liquor traffic. In the old saloon days he refused to sign petitions for the opening of new bars. Later he supported local option; later still as Speaker of the Lower House of the Oregon Legislature he was active and influential in promoting all dry legislation, and as United States Senator he has never failed to vote for measures that would help to strangle the liquor business. His record in helping to put the rum traffic out of business is one hundred per cent.

I have been a practical fighting prohibitionist for twenty-five years. I have learned that you can't afford to try experiments in a show-down fight with the commercialized liquor interests. Here in Oregon the Anti-Saloon League has deserted a sure thing and has gone to flirting with an experiment. The leadership of the Anti-Saloon League in Oregon at the present time is without vision or practical common sense and totally unreliable. They are ingrates of the first order.

TIMBER AND LUMBER

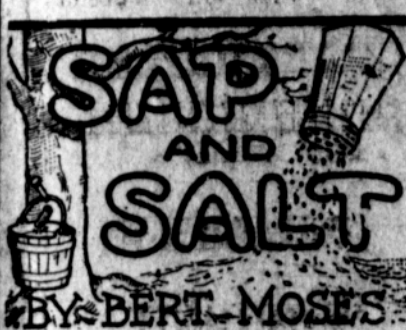
The capital stock tax was a war tax. In a measure it was double taxation and it was a business killer. When the tax reduction measures were introduced in this Congress the administration asked that this tax be abolished. Formidable opposition developed. The Senate Committee on Finance, of which Senator Stanfield is a member, has charge of all tax measures in the Senate. This capital stock tax reduction seemed hopeless, but Senator Stanfield argued before the committee that lumber was Oregon's principal industry; that at the present time it was operating under heavy handicaps, and that this tax was a paralyzer, and in justice to the people of Oregon and Washington it should be removed. The committee voted to abolish the tax, Senator Stanfield casting the deciding vote. Will the timber interests of Jackson County, will the people of Jackson County who are depending more and more on the development of this industry for their prosperity, remember this on primary day!

GENERAL TAXES

Senator Stanfield is chairman of the Public Lands Committee of the Senate. At this time he has in charge and is pushing as rapidly as possible, tax recovery measures for the state of Oregon, involving over six millions of dollars. Better than five million dollars for the eighteen Oregon and California Land Grant counties, and almost one million dollars for the Lincoln county spruce lands. Senator Stanfield, with the loyal support of the rest of Oregon's congressional delegation, will put these through. Jackson County's share will be one million dollars. Every tax payer in this county should go to the polls next Friday with this in mind.
