to the City Recorder, By order of the Common Council.

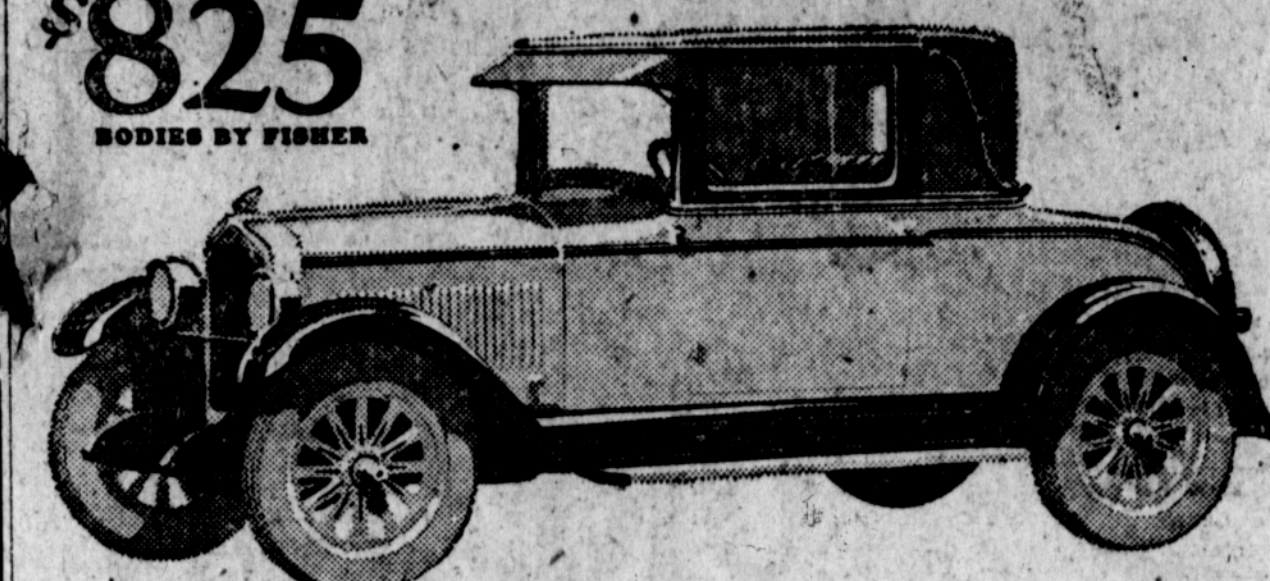

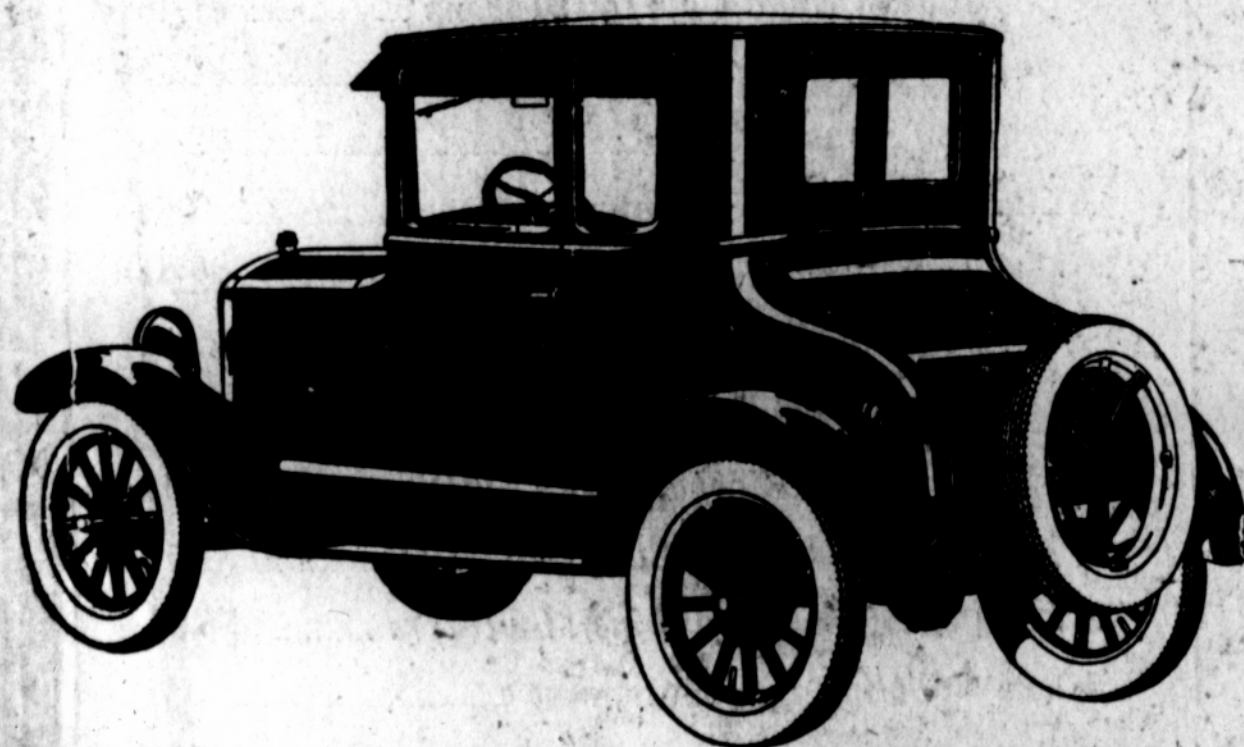

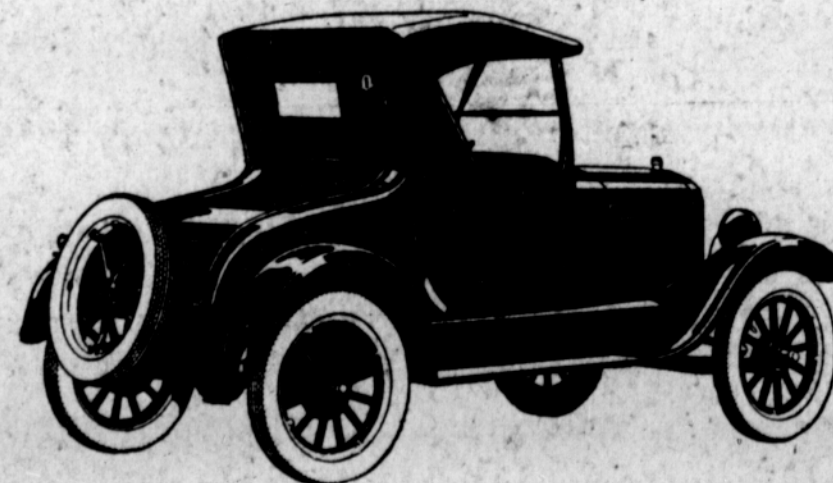
