Pink Salmon Are Absent This Year

SEATTLE, Wash., Absence of pink salmon in Puget Sound this year will result in only 10 of the 22 canneries on its shores operating, according to Lee B. Carroll, Anacortes cannery man.

The behavior of the pinks is unexplainable. Pink salmon appear in Puget Sound only every two years, on the odd numbered years. In the meantime it is a question where they go, according to Sarroll. Experts may only speculate, he said. They may go to the Arctic wastes and hibernate under ice floes, or spend the season in some warm depth in the tropics. But they always return every two years, Carroll said, as proved by the tags researchers have placed on them.

Because this is the off-year for pinks, the canneries which are running will have to be content with the lighter colored fish and the more inferior grades.

With respect to the "sock eye" or famous red variety, the case is twice as bad, according to Carroll, who has studied the habits of salmon for years.

"When the sock eyes go they stay away for four years," he said.

Ten Thousand sealed bottles will be turned loose in New York Harbor as part of a plan for study of current and tidal changes in the ocean.

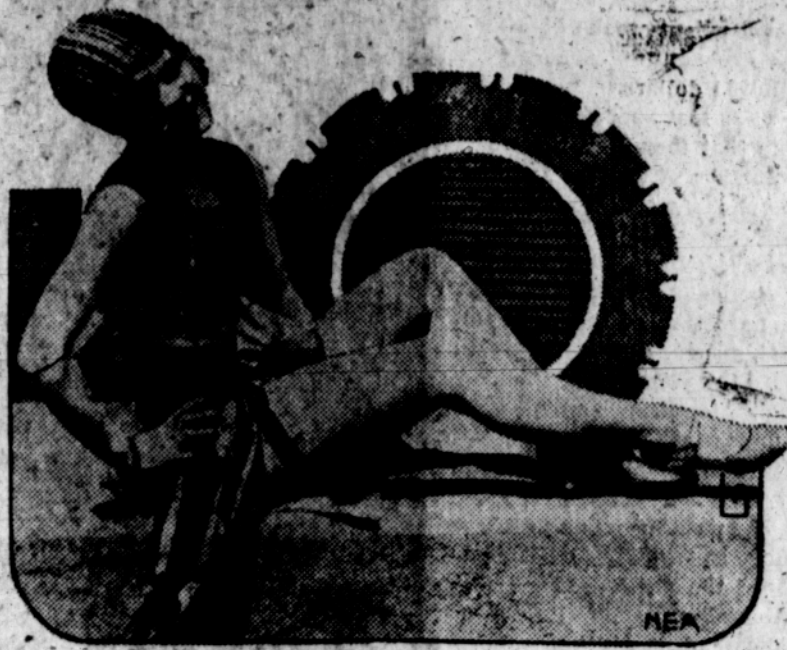

Practically every county in the

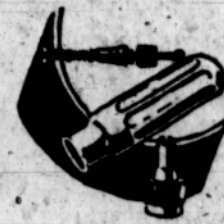
state has been represented by patients at the White Shield, according to Envoy Gray. The door is always open to the unfortunate, and many are the pathetic unfortunates who ring the door bell.

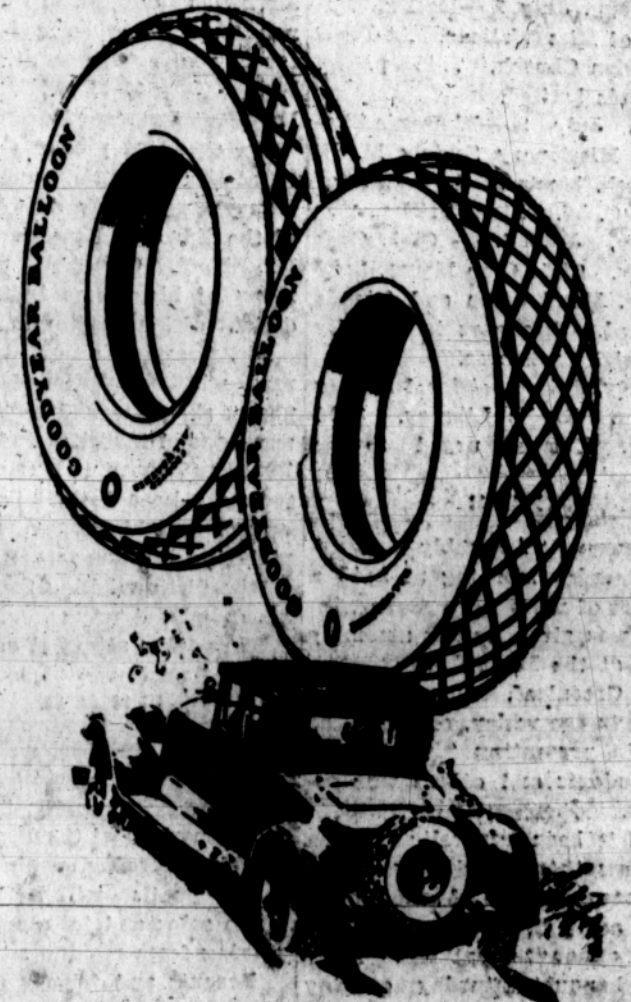
