#### THE ASHLAND NORMAL

The magnificent new home of the Southern Oregon. Normal school at Ashland was dedicated Saturday afternoon, June 26, with ceremonies properly befitting the occasion. The event marks a new and improved era in the educational circles of Southern Oregon and restores to Ashland and this section of the state an institution long required.

The completion of the imposing structure which is to house the school is an auspicious occasion for our sister city. Ashland is primarily a beautiful city of schools, churches, homes and culture. No city in Oregon offers better home life and environment for an institution of higher learning. The spiendid environment which abounds in that city has been in the hashing for the past half century, and in no city or town in Oregon has it reached a higher plane.

The restoration of the normal school and the completion of the beautiful structure that is to house the school constitute a real asset to Ashland and Southern Oregon as a whole. Ashland is manifesting justifiable pride in the school and all of Southern Oregon joins in sharing her

#### HALANCED EDUCATION

Eighty-two boys in the graduating class of the Jefferson High School in Portland earned \$64,383.50 during their high school course, the average for the class of 93 being \$682.50. One boy, Neil Bodey, earned \$2,280. The girls earned an average of \$71.05, with 48 girls collecting \$3454.60; and Alma Lorenz earned \$500.

#### LET'S MAKE OUR ROADS WIDER

More than 40,000 miles of highways will be paved this year, after which the mileage of hard-surfaced roads in the United States will be in excess of 500,000. This is twice the improved road mileage of ten years ago, says the New York Commercial.

Standards of hiving cannot be raised nor industrial progress made in the mud. But we are rapidly approaching the time when the linear measurement of our roads will not be as important as width and load-carrying capacity. If every state in the Union was honeycombed with paved highways, it would be a number of years before we would acutely deel the need for increased road width. But all states are not, nor is there any immediate prospect of their reaching that point. This results in forcing the constantly increasing motor traffic on to the existing stretches of pavement, with congestion, delay, accidents and rapid highways depreciation as a result.

They cannot cease writing such insurance, and they are starting an investigation to determine how to write such policies and at least break even.
