## HOUSEWIVES URGED TO SWAT ALL FLIES

WASHINGTON, (UP)—Start swatting the fly now. Uncle Sam wants housewives through the U. S. Department of Agriculture, "Careful screen of windows and doors during the summer months, with supplementary use of sticky fly papers is one of the best protective measures known against house flies," he advises. "Fly poisons are also helpful in eradicating the pests but arsenic preparations should be carefully handled and placed out of reach of children. A very effective fly poison is made by adding three teaspoonfuls of commercial formalin to a pint of sweet milk or water sweetened with a little brown sugar." Flies breed in filth, housewives are told by the government. Refuse and garbage should be burned when possible or put in cans with tight lids.
