upon the statute of the United States in November 1921, a 5-year period which means that the appropriation will expire June 30, 1927. \$1,240,000 is available each year of which \$5000 is granted outright to each state and the remainder apportioned to the states according to population if matched by state funds; the program is initiated and administered under certain federal supervision and regulation, by the states themselves; its purpose is broadly educational, preventive rather than curative, and designed to stimulate local initiative and responsibility.

This federal aid provided has now been accepted by 43 states and the territory of Hawaii. Twenty-six are now matching the federal funds in full and of the remaining 17 operating under the Act 2 are matching within \$500 the total sums available. Therefore figured roughly, \$4,790,000 are being devoted specifically to the promotion of the welfare and hygiene of mothers and children.

But despite the importance of dollars in this or any other program of human well-being, it is far more important to measure success in terms of service and achievement.

The program stresses education regarding prenatal confinement, post natal care, and the hygiene of infancy and pre-school age. Figures mount into thousands and millions in the number of health conferences for mothers, mid-wives, and children; number of bulletins issued by the Children's Bureau; monthly pre-natal letters sent to given names and addresses home visits and demonstrations, dental clinics, etc.

The serious needs of rural and isolated population groups always foremost in the minds of the advocates of this Act and but few city activities have been developed except as temporary demonstrations and training centers. Oregon received attention in last year's national report when the health officials, impressed by the absence of "instruction in child culture" at the county fairs where animals and crops were receiving unlimited attention, stationed nurses there to explain health values, model layettes, diet lists for children, etc.

While it is still too early to attempt to measure the results of this enormous educational program in terms of the actual saving of lives, it is known that Kentucky's infant death rate has been reduced 6 per cent in the last year and that Oregon heads the list with the lowest infant death rate which is 53 deaths among every 1000 children under one year of age. However, the United States in this respect, does not save babies lives as well as 8 foreign countries and saves mothers' lives only half as well as the British, so a vast amount remains to be done before we may be satisfied with the protection provided for mothers and children.
