But Chicago, at present, has a perfect example of that axiom about taking an exception to prove any rule. Such an example is Joe McCarthy, new Cub manager, who came direct from the minors to take charge of a major league baseball team.

"They don't know Joe in Chicago yet. But they do know this: He has taken what, on paper, looks like one of the worst teams in the league and whipped it into a fighting aggregation that is feared all over the league.

Here's a general summing up that one might get out of most any person connected with McCarthy:

"I don't know much about Joe. But he's sure got it when it comes to bossing a ball club. Look what he's done with the Cubs."

One of Joe's greatest assets seems to be his power to instill fight into his men. He has them hopping from the word go—even the boys riding the bench. In connection with the latter Joe has introduced something new. He has a manager for them. The manager is Mike Dolan. It's Mike's job to see that there is plenty of "pop" on the bench.

One reason that they don't know so much about McCarthy yet is his seeming disregard for any publicity. An instance of this occurred in a Philadelphia hotel the other day.

A reporter met him in the lobby. "Any news?" he asked Joe. "No, nothing yet, except I have suspended Alexander indefinitely."

Electricity Will Keep Trout Away From Dam Intake

Many denizens of the Rogue River will soon be talking about the Gold Ray dam. It has long been a source of irritation to trout and salmon alike that the finest and most adventurous of their tribes dived down a dark hole near the upper end of the fishway never to return.

Probably the only residents of the river who didn't mind the power plant inlet, and who will not be flustered by the report, are the long eels who suck their way up over the rocks at the south end of the dam.

The news that will soon be flying up and down the river will be of some black bars near the front of the dark hole. These bars, the fish will say, hit a fellow right on the nose without touching him.

And if the bars hit hard enough and the talk spreads far enough the fish will probably find similar sources of surprise at the Savage Rapids dam on down the river and above the falls at Oregon City.

All of which means that the California-Oregon Power company has tried its floating chain screen at Gold Ray unsuccessfully and is now going ahead with its substitute plan of electrifying the bars across the power plant intake. The company will try 110 volts and if that isn't enough a stronger charge will be applied.

If the experiments are successful similar electric screens will be installed at Savage Rapids and Oregon City, according to E. F. Averill, state game warden.

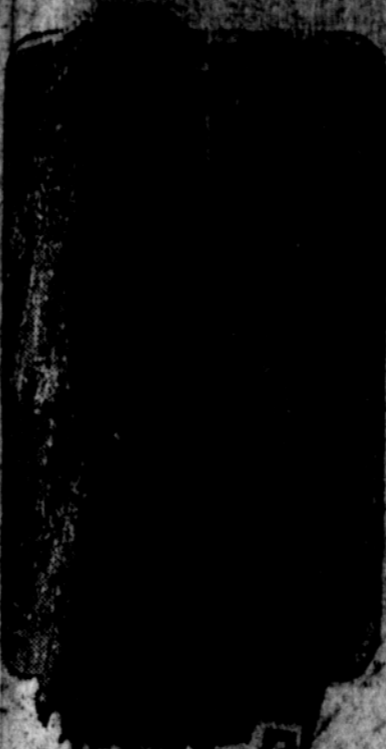

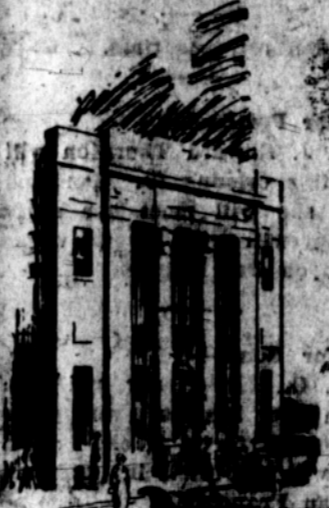

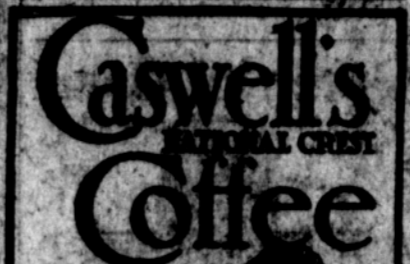
