WASHINGTON — Watch Senator James A. Reed of Missouri. All signs are that he is gaining strength every day as a Democratic presidential possibility.

Among politicians still in Washington — despite the congressional recess, they're constantly drifting out and in, with tidings from all over the country — the increasing frequency of references to him, as such, is surprising.

Here are some of the things one hears in his favor:

He has a tremendous personality. He has ability. He's an indomitable fighter. In his home state he has proved himself a wonderful campaigner and vote getter.

Al Smith has all these qualities, but he's known somewhat too exclusively as a wet.

So is Gov. Albert C. Hitchie of Maryland.

While Reed's a wet, he stands for numerous other policies which ought to take some of the curse off his wetness even in dry territory.

William G. McAdoo would be all right for the dries but has nothing to recommend him to any of the wets.

Procrastination Is British Habit

LONDON, (U P) — Government procrastination in England is beginning to rival that of the Orient, according to a recent

statement in the House of Commons by Ronald McNeill, Financial Secretary of the Treasury.

McNeill pointed out that more than four years ago a committee headed by Lord Meuston, was appointed to investigate the grant system in education. An immediate report by the committee was expected immediately but each month the report was asked for it was promised. "In another month."

The final meeting of the committee was called in March, 1922, and during the summer of 1921 a complete report was promised

to Parliament. McNeill declared that the patience of the government, Parliament and the public was exhausted awaiting the report to publish it.
