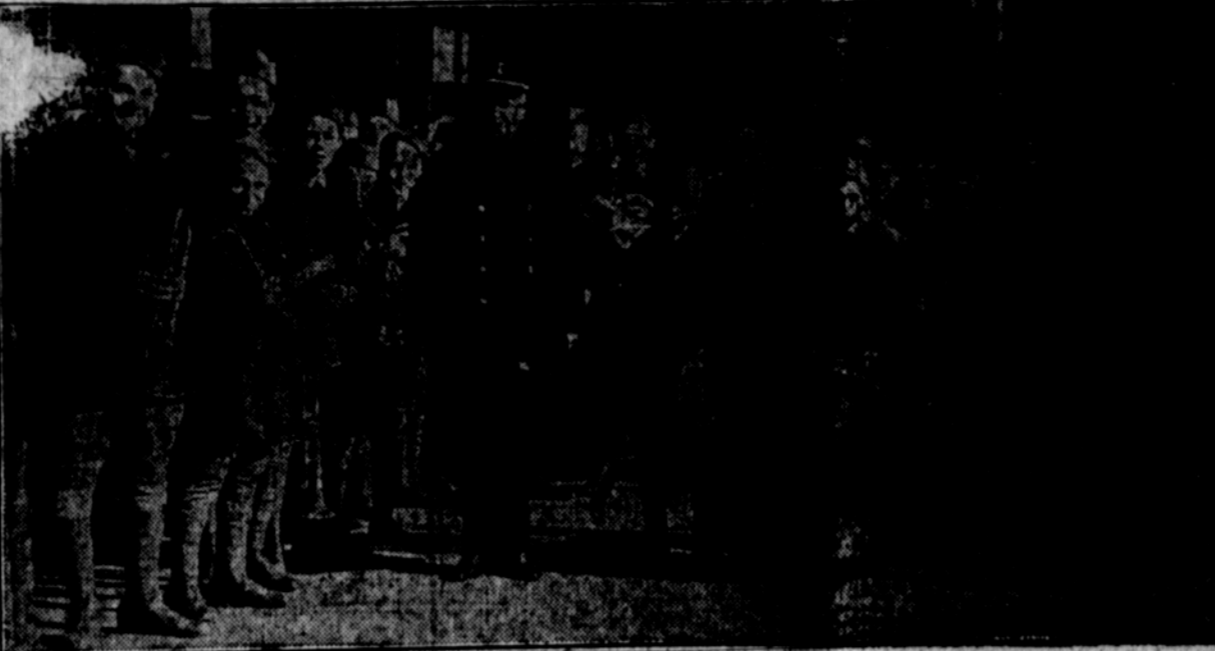

executive, the courtesy of a section of the state highway department. The woman governor asks re-election on her record in office and the State Democratic Executive Committee departed from its custom by giving her a "vote of confidence" and appealed to the democrats to "accord a faithful

and term in office." In the face of the committee's action, Moody and Davidson have scoured the state with an appeal to voters to "rid the state of Fergusonism," built around the former governor's admitted domination of his wife's administration. Re-election of the woman governor, it is charged, is paramount to "election" of Ferguson to a fourth term. Ferguson was impeached and removed from office in 1917 while serving his second term.
