Snake Authority Visits Berkeley

(UP)—The man who is scientifically accomplishing in South America what St. Patrick mythologically accomplished for Ireland is a guest at the University of California.

He is Dr. Afranio de Assum, director of the Anti-Venom Institute of Sao Paulo, Brazil. Dr. Amaral's anti-toxin is an antidote to snake bites both on humans and cattle. The savant, who also is instructor in tropical medicine at Harvard, said the importance of the anti-toxin is not so well known in the United States as in South America.

The annual death rate from snake bites in the south American republic is 300 annually. Dr. Amaral declared. The efficacy of his anti-toxin has been demonstrated in Texas where out of 15 victims of rattler bite to receive his treatment, 23 recovered. The two others, beyond reach, died.

Poisonous snake bites caused a loss of well above \$1,000,000 annually to cattle in Texas and New Mexico, Dr. Amaral said.

A comparatively light vote was anticipated throughout the state, leaders of the two major parties said.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., Aug. 10.—(UP)—Arkansas voters were deciding at the polls today for the first time since the reconstruction whether an Arkansas governor will fail to secure a second term endorsement.

Governor Thomas J. Terral, seeking a second term, is opposed in the primary election by Judge John E. Martineau, who as candidate for the Democratic primary nomination in 1924 finished third in a field of six. Not since post-Civil War days has a governor in this state been defeated for a second term.

The gubernatorial campaign has revolved about administration of the state textbook commission and Terral's prison policy. Senator Thaddeus H. Carraway's bid for renomination seems to have struck no decided opposition. Seven representatives are also seeking a return to Washington.

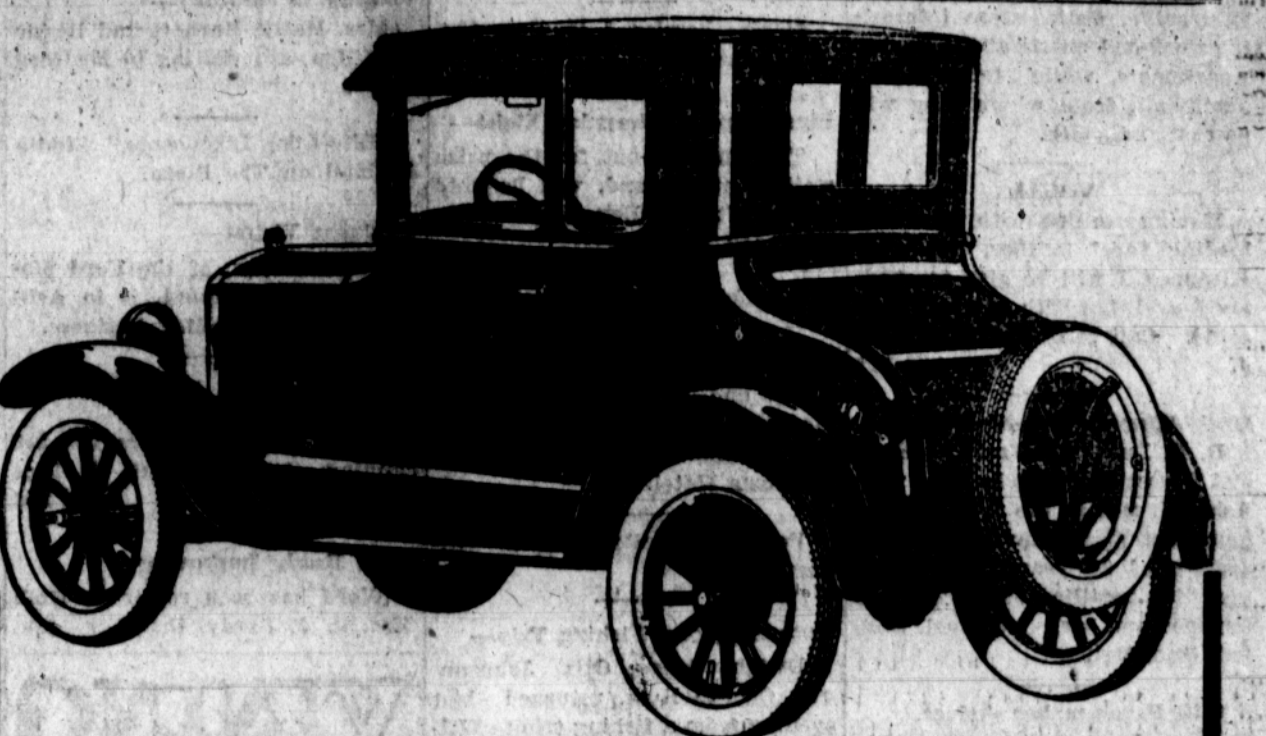
