In addition to creeks, lakes and other topo graphic fedtures, foods, trails, railfoods, telephone lines, ranger stations and Bookout points as well as the new line of the Southeral Pacific rathroad over the Cascades, are shown Main motor fighways appear in red. On the back of the map, text

and pictures explain the purposes and resources of the Cascade national forest. The four major forest resources of timber, forese and recreation are described. principlay auto trips listed and table of elevations given.

The text concludes with a statement of the forest protection organisation and some suggestions for public cooperation in forest fire prevention. The only obligation imposed by the forest service on each person receiving a map is to be careful with fire in the forest and to help in teaching the principles of forest protection and outdoors good manners.


