The British star is also known as Lady Peel, wife of an English nobleman. The plaintiff, Mrs. Priscilla Whelan, charges that Miss Lillie and her husband, Timothy F. Whelan, occupied the Whelan residence in Hollywood while she, at the specific request of her husband, was taking a vacation on Catalina island.

Miss Lillie came to Los Angeles six months ago as the leading lady in Charlot's Revue and for the past two months has been engaged in motion picture work at the Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer studios, where Whelan is a comedy constructor.

Promotion Day to Be Staged Sunday

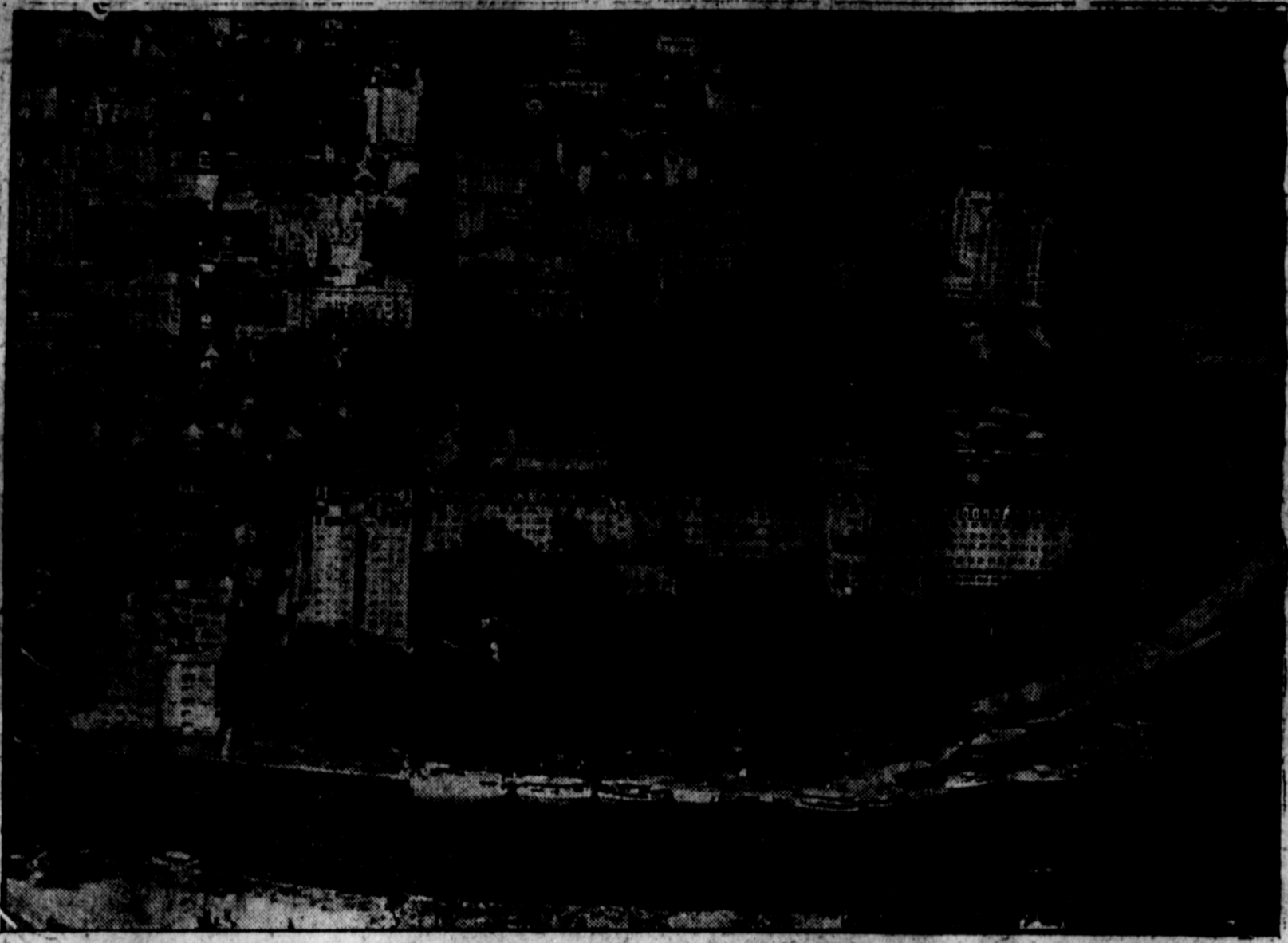
