LIQUOR INTERESTS WANT WHISKEY BACK

LOS ANGELES, Calif., Sept. 28.—Liquor interests are making a clever and extensive drive for the return of all intoxicating liquors, according to Mrs. Ella A. Boole, national president of the C. T. U., in the keynote speech at the annual convention here yesterday.

Mrs. Boole said, in part: "The opponents of prohibition do not want light wines and beer; they do not want the denaturation of intoxicating liquor changed from one-half of one per cent. to liquors 'non-intoxicating in fact'. What they really want is, intoxicating liquors. What they are aiming for is the repeal of the Eighteenth Amendment and to ward that end they are using the keenest strategy. The wedge is the keynote of naval strategy. The guiding hand in the Association Against the Prohibition Amendment is a naval man. The activities of this and kindred organizations have been deliberately and skillfully planned. Every move connected therewith has
