TRINIDAD, Colo., Oct. 12. (United News)—That Miss Rose M. Purdue, former Milwaukee social worker, was the victim of bootleggers because she told "too much," was the belief of officers who today are searching the mountains near here for traces of the murderer.
Miss Purdue, whose body, riddled with buckshot, was found in a canyon 14 miles west of Trinidad Friday, was said to have been active in reporting operations of bootlegging to officers. The latter are inclined to regard her murder as the revenge of the sparsely populated mountainous region of this section of Colorado.
