JAP COLONIZATION PLAN USES BIG MEXICAN ARENAS

TOKYO, Japan, (U.P.) - A Japanese Company is being organized by Mr. K. Taura, with a capital of one million yen or about \$500,000 gold, for colonization work in Mexico, according to the Osaka Mainichi, which states the Company has obtained 14,700 acres in San Luis Potosi. The rice, bananas and cattle.
Another project, headed by Mr. Yoshizo Minawaka, is for colonization of a tract near Mexico City with Japanese farmers, according to the newspaper, while still a third project headed by Toshio Onedra, calls for organization of a company with a capital of 1,500,000 yen colonizing a Mexican tract.

G. O. P. STATE CONVENTION OPENS AT PROVIDENCE
PROVIDENCE, R. I., Oct. 13. (UP) - With no seat in the United States Senate to be filled, most of the interest centered around local contests as Rhode Island Republicans opened their convention here today.
The G. O. P. state ticket, with one or two exceptions, was expected to be the same as in 1924. Aram J. Pothier, Rhode Island's 72-year-old governor, has announced his intention of seeking re-election, and indications were he would receive no opposition in the convention.
Lieut. Gov. Nathaniel Smith also is expected to seek re-election.
Congressmen Clark Burdick of the first district and Richard S. Aldrich of the second district were expected to be renominated for Congress. Louis Monast, who was defeated two years ago by Congressman Jeremiah O'Connell, probably will be the Republican's choice for the third district.
