Fresno Youth Is Developing Plants

FRESNO, Cal., Nov. 24.—(U. P.)—A Fresno youth who has barely attained his majority is attracting attention throughout the west through his work in the plant world. Agricultural experts of the San Joaquin valley believe he is destined to follow the path created by the late Luther Burbank.

He is William H. Henderson and at the ranch home of his mother Mrs. H. T. Logan, he has created a veritable wilderness of plant life.

Among his principal experiments which seem prospective of success is the propagation of a highly perfumed gladiolus, one of California's most popular flowers.

Improvement of the size, texture and fragrance of certain varieties of roses.

Production of new and improved varieties of almonds, peaches and oranges, and development of size, flavor and fragrance of existing varieties.

Domesticating of California wild flowers, with particular attention to the California wild lily.
