**LETTERS OF VOLTA FOUND IN VIENNA**  
 VIENNA — (UN) — Intense interest has been aroused in scientific circles of Central Europe by the announcement that research workers have discovered in the imperial archives of the Hapsburgs a number of letters written by Alessandro Volta, pioneer in the development of electricity.  
 In these letters, written 120 years ago, Count Volta explained several of the experiments which were being made by him while the rest of the world still believed that electricity was a substance used by the gods as an instrument of destruction when the peoples of the earth displeased them. The discovery of the letters has been made just in time for a memorial edition of them to be issued on the hundredth anniversary of his death, March 1927.  
 During a busy life of eighty-two years, Volta upset several theories of his fellow-scientists while at the same time discovering many new theories which are still accepted.
