BUCHAREST, Dec. 10.—(UN)—The throne room where King Ferdinand and Queen Marie have welcomed many a grizzled diplomat to Rumania, while statesmen planned intrigue beneath carmine curtains, was a mass of charred wreckage tonight.

It will cost \$104,000 to repair the entire central section of the palace as reception rooms, state halls and the great audience chamber itself all were destroyed by the flames.
