NEW METHOD OF THE DEAF TO HEAR FOUND

New Device Will Allow Use of Eyes to Transmit Sounds
 NEW YORK, Dec. 21.—(UN)—Teaching the deaf to "hear" with their eyes is now a practical possibility, according to J. W. Legg, research engineer of the Westinghouse laboratories, and inventor of a new device known as the "osio."
 The instrument translates sound vibrations into visible waves which are reproduced on a tiny mirror. Although the principle of the device is old this is the first time it has ever been applied to a portable instrument.
 Extensive experiments now being made by Dr. Robert Gault of the national research council in Washington are expected to lead development of a device to be carried in the pocket by deaf persons. By watching the mirror it will be possible for them to understand ordinary conversation and even plays, and music.

EVIDENCE COLLAPSE RUINS AIMEE CASE

State's Star Witness Admits That Her Testimony Was Perjured
 LOS ANGELES, Dec. 20.—(UN)—Possibility that Aimee Semple McPherson and her co-defendants in the famous "kidnaping" case will never be tried loomed here today as the result of accusations hurled by Mrs. Lorraine Wiseman, "hoax" woman, and the state's star witness.
 District Attorney Ann Keyes virtually admitted that the state's case, built on the testimony of Mrs. Wiseman, was about to collapse, following her statement that indicates she perjured herself on the stand during the preliminary hearing of the evangelist.
 Keyes declared that he believed it would now be impossible to obtain a conviction because of the complications that have followed Mrs. Wiseman's allegations and strongly intimated that the charges against Mrs. McPherson, her mother, Mrs. Minnie Kennedy and Kenneth G. Orniston, would be dropped.

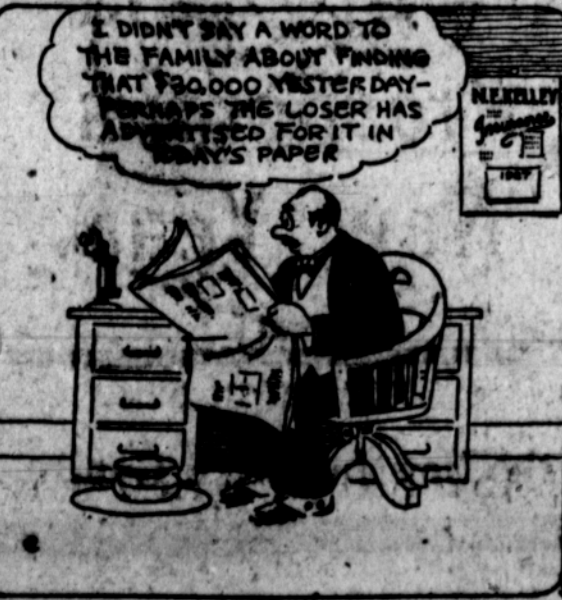
