WILL RENEW SEARCH FOR PORTLAND YOUTH

PORTLAND, Jan. 14.—(UN)—Hope for the recovery of the body of Leslie Brownie, the youth who was lost 12 days ago on the south slope of Mount Hood, and for a solution of the mystery surrounding his disappearance in a blizzard while attempting to be first to climb the mountain in the new year, was revived Wednesday, when it was learned that Mark Weygant and Bill Lens, two experienced mountaineers has visited Portland in the interests of the case and were preparing to make another trip over the district where the boy was lost.

ANDREW'S NAME IS LINKED WITH BOOTLEGGERS

Head of Prohibition Department Involved in Liquor Trial

NEW YORK, Jan. 14.—(UN)—The name of Lincoln C. Andrews, assistant secretary of treasury in charge of prohibition enforcement, was calmly bandied about by rum runners as a partner in their enterprises, it was testified at the Costello brothers \$25,000,000 rum row conspiracy.

The testimony which was unsubstantiated was given by Samuel D. Briggs, now a prohibition agent under A. Bruce Bielaski. He has admitted taking \$100 of the rum runner's bribe money.

Briggs said the story was told him by Phillip J. Coffey, one of the defendants and an alleged "pay off" man for the rum runners. The rum ship involved was the schooner Athena. He fixed the time as October, 1925.

"Coffey told me," Samuel D. Briggs testified, "that two men, presumably government agents, had come to New London. One

was introduced as Mr. Wilson. "Coffey told me not to worry about these two men. That Mr. Wilson was General Andrews' personal representative and the Athena's cargo was jointly owned by the Coffey people and General Andrews, and explained that after all expenses had been paid General Andrews share of the transaction would amount to approximately \$2,000.

"But he told me that after they had once got started they planned to make a trip each week, and as there were 52 weeks a year it would be about \$100,000 that General Andrews would receive."
