CARBON ADVANTAGE SAYS AUTO EXPERT

"When any type of gasoline is used in an automobile engine, a certain amount of carbon is deposited on the piston head and combustion chamber. This carbon deposit gradually increases until the familiar 'carbon shock' or 'ignition knock' becomes apparent.
