ROYAL FAMILY ARE VISITING TROPICS

viously by the visit of the Prince of Wales in the same warship in April, 1920.

Launched speed out to meet the Renown, and as the gigantic vessel crept slowly to her mooring in the harbor, launches and a flotilla of native canoes swarmed around her. Their occupants shouted glad cries of welcome, the native tongue mingling colorfully with the lusty greetings of the Britishers. The Duke of York, with the tiny duchess

standing alongside him, acknowledged the reception from the bridge of the Renown.

Governor Sir Eyre Hutson visited the duke as the vessel docked, warmly welcoming him to the hospitality of the British Empire in the Western Pacific, of which Suva is the headquarters. The Duke and Duchess of York gave a dinner aboard tonight, attended by the leading residents, including government officials and businessmen.

Officers of the Renown told of a crossing-the-line ceremony. The men and officers of the Renown evolved a sea pageant, on a scale of magnificence only previously rivaled by a smaller ceremony on the ship during the Prince of Wales' visit seven years ago. High naval and military officers took part in a well-organized scenic display. The duke did not enter into it personally as Wales did.

Proceedings began just before the ship crossed the equator, when a fearsome King Neptune, surrounded by his "court," a crowd of British bluejackets garbed in all kinds of fantastic costumes, hailed Captain Sull-

van on the bridge, apparently from the sea. The captain stopped the ship and invited Neptune aboard. Rockets sent up from the forecastle disclosed Neptune and a few attendants emerging from a hawsepipe. Sullivan megaphoned an invitation to come on the flag-deck, where Neptune was received in formal state by the duke and others with witty, topical speeches. Neptune in turn welcomed the duke and duchess to his domain of the Seven Seas, and the duke was invited as a member of "Our Sea King's Brotherhood" and invested with the Order of the Equatorial Bath.
