ographs were taken of the new buildings erected during the last year or more, such as the Normal School, Lincoln School, McGee's Store, etc., in order that these might be used in various publications and opportunities for advertising. For furnishing these photos and cuts \$66.57 was expended. During these months the bill board advertising which Foster & Kleiser Company contracted for with the Chamber was carried on, and during the month of June the large advertising board south of Ashland was moved to a location beyond the Klamath Falls Junction, in order to give the tourist a correct indication as to distance into Ashland and Lithia Park.

Assistance was given to the county school program held in Ashland each year in the nature of cash prizes for the music memory contest, and prizes were also given for an essay contest at the High School. Postcards of the Auto Camp were also provided which are used weekly for a large mailing list. Signs and arrows for direction to the auto camp were also provided and placed in suitable positions.

During the month of July the electric sign which was contracted for in April was erected in the Plaza. Co-operation and financial assistance was given to the Lion's Club of Medford in placing their big advertising program at their national convention in San Francisco.

During the months of August, September and October the advertising expenditures were not large being confined mainly to detail work in the office with the tourist travel, disturbing large quantities of maps and literature relating to Oregon, Jackson County and Ashland, also some special attention was given to sign boards directing to Lithia Park and Auto Camp. During the month of July the advertising committee furnished a special cup for the tennis tournament held in Lithia Park.

In October our Foster and Kleiser bill board south of Ashland was repainted calling attention particularly to Ashland's superior hotel and auto camp facilities. In November publicity through a combination of the Ashland and Medford Chambers of Commerce was given to the Normal School program for the state.
