NOTICE TO MILK DEALERS Your attention is again called to City Ordinance No. 773 which provides that all milk and cream producers; who intend to sell milk or cream ultimately to be used by the residents of the City of Ashland, shall, before offering any such milk or cream for sale either within the City of Ashland or to others who intend to sell said milk or cream within the City of Ashland, register their names with the City Recorder in order that an accurate list may be maintained of all milk and cream producers.


