stedt, Gray would not have lived through his experience.

Following the accident the company made the usual report to the National Electric Light Association and after thorough investigation of all circumstances the National Safety Council authorized the award of the Insull Medal to Knackstedt for his prompt and efficient action in a vital emergency.

But Few Medals Since the inception a few years ago of the Insull Medal Award which is given for resuscitation from electric shock by means of the Shafer Prone Pressure Method, only a comparatively few of these medals have been awarded in the entire United States. The Shafer Method is general conceded by authorities to be the most efficient means yet devised for successful resuscitation from electric shock, gas asphyxiation and drowning and has been used many times with phenomenal success in restoring life to persons apparently dead.

Copco employees have been carefully trained in the use of the Shafer Method and that it has been effective is proven by the number of successful cases which are now on record.

The official presentation of the Knackstedt medal was made last Tuesday night at the Siskiyou Division headquarters of the company at Yreka, California, by P. O. Crawford, Vice-President and General Manager of The California Oregon Power Company, who was selected by The National Electric Light Association to make the award. In making the presentation Mr. Crawford gave a most interesting address upon the subject of "accident prevention," calling attention to the value of preparedness and commend- ing Knackstedt for cool and efficient method of handling the emergency which arose. He also stressed the need of carefully avoiding accidents, through being mentally alert at all times.

"Statistics show that seven out of every ten accidents could be prevented," stated Mr. Crawford, who went on to show that five out of these seven could be avoided through proper educa-

tion in this regard, the other two being possible through the use of better safeguards. "Man lives for service," said Crawford, "and the greater service he renders the more he profits." "On this case Mr. Knackstedt has rendered the greatest service of all, that of saving the life of his fellow-man."

Give Short Talks Short talks on the subject of accident prevention were also made by Mr. S. M. Ballis, who has charge of safety work for The California Oregon Power Company, and O. G. Steels, Manager of the Siskiyou Division. A large group of employees from all parts of the company's Northern California territory was present at the meeting. Motion pictures of the presentation ceremony were taken and will soon be available for showing.
