**SPOKANE**, Wash., June 3.—(AP)—Al Fassett, "King of the White waters," lies in a hospital here today suffering serious illness as a result of his "dope devil" attempt to shoot the falls below Spokane.

**FORTLAND**, Ore., June 3.—(AP)—Appearing with a petition for a certificate of necessity and convenience, backers of the Wilson River toll bridge project appeared before the public service commission Thursday.

**SETTLE DOHENY RECEIVERSHIP**  
**WASHINGTON**, June 3.—(AP)—The government will receive approximately \$23,000,000 from the Elk Hills, California naval oil reserve, the navy department estimated today in announcing termination of the federal receivership there.

The government will receive \$11,013,000 in cash and Liberty bonds, accumulated from sale of storage oil since the receivership, and over \$12,000,000 from the E. L. Doheny companies in judgment of oil taken out prior to that time.
