## **BULES AND REGULATIONS Ashland Golf Course**

1-The rules of the United States Golf Association will govern all competition and all players are requested to familiarize themselves with such rules.

2-High-heeled shoes will not be allowed on the course

3-No players shall play until the parties in front are out of range, nor play up to any putting green until the players in front have holed out and moved away.

-Driving a ball from any putting green is prohibited. Hole flags must not be stuck into turf or putting greens. They should either be held in hand or carefully laid down while putting but and afterwards placed in cup.

5-Golf bags or clubs must not be thrown or laid on the putting greens.

6-Turf cut or displaced by a stroke or otherwise, must be replaced at once and pressed down with foot.

7-The player whose ball is fartherest from the flag must in all cases play first, while his apponents must remain back and out of range of the player's ball.

The irrigation system is said to be one of the best operated by any golf club. Social and recreational activities of a community often tell the story of whether the community is a live one or whether it is self-satisfied.


