schools of the entire county.

At present the small district with an assessed valuation of about \$50,000.00 and with 15 or 16 children to educate has to struggle to maintain a school with bare necessities, while a large district with close to \$1,000,000.00 assessed valuation and with less than 100 children to educate gets a fine school with a few mills tax. The large district has twenty times the valuation and only six times as many children. Such inequalities would be eliminated under the county unit plan.

At present the seventy-four (74) school clerks of Jackson County receive between \$3500.00 and \$4000.00 for their services, some receive more than \$25.00 a year while others are paid for census work, etc. For that same amount the county could be supplied with a competent school clerk and a music supervisor.

The board members are not paid a salary, but under county unit each receives mileage for attendance at board meetings. In Klamath County meetings are held on an average of once in three weeks making the expense of the board meetings about \$250 or \$260 a year.

Business is carried on on a cash basis, so that there are no outstanding warrants. If funds are needed to meet bills before the receipt of apportionment money, money is borrowed from the bank. Supplies are purchased at wholesale prices which means a great saving to the parents and taxpayers of the county.

At present some districts with school plants and school finances in good condition do not feel like sharing their wealth with some less favored district which has not made the struggle they have, but in the years to come when their turn comes for help, they will get it from the common fund of the unit district. Again some district free from debt do not feel like assuming a share of the indebtedness, but on the other hand the bonded district probably has a well built and well equipped building to contribute to the unit district.

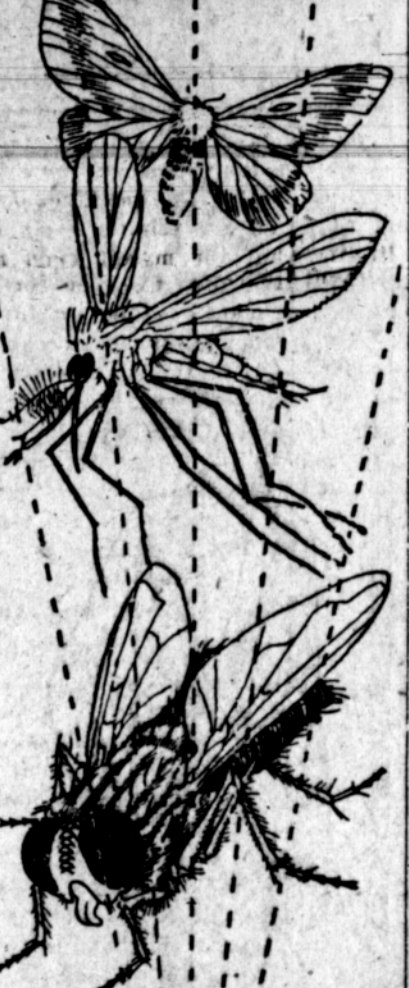
