SALEM, Ore., July 1—(P)—Succeeding W. A. Marshall, veteran member of the state industrial accident commission who resigned recently, W. H. Fitzgerald, well-known labor leader, was today named to fill that position.

Marshall left today for Seattle where he will take up his new duties as deputy commissioner in charge of the new seaman's and longshoremen's compensation act.

SEATTLE FIREMAN KILLED
SEATTLE, July 1—(P)—Darwin Lund, city fireman, was killed here this afternoon when the fire truck on which he was riding to a fire crashed with a street car at Fourth avenue and Bell street. Lund was hurled through the air to the street, dying almost instantly.
