Among the visitors to the re ception tomorrow will be many city officials, executives of business, civie and professional organizations and other leaders in the life of the community, who have been specially invited.

The performance of these new cars, it is said, will be startling when viewed in the light of automobile performance of the past.

Local dealers have been notified by Ford officials at Detroit that the factories throughout the country are now preparing to produce the new cars in numbers exceeding even the tremendous production records achieved in the manufacture of the Model T. line.

Company officials at Detroit also repeated their early announcement that production of the new Ford line will not make the Model T line obsolete. The manufacture of new parts for Model T. replacements will continue to be an important factor of the Ford plants as long as any of the Model T cars are still in operation, the local dealers were advised.
