CONSTRUCTIVE OR OBSTRUCTIVE, WHICH?

At a mass meeting recently

some forty citizens supposedly interested

in the advancement of the city

gathered to consider the proposed contract

of the American City Bureau with the Commercial Club

to put on a membership and budget campaign.

After due discussion it was voted not advisable

to employ the bureau for the campaign,

the majority of those present said they favored the enterprise

proposed by the club for increasing its membership and budget,

but believed that the present club membership could accomplish the undertaking

without the intervention of the American City Bureau.

It was decided to cancel the contract made by the directors

of the club with the bureau. And it was so ordered.

Now the Commercial Club stands exactly where it did before

the proposed campaign was started.

There has been considerable effort expended,

especially by this newspaper, in an attempt to educate the citizenship

to the necessity for such a movement and we feel that the enthusiasm

already aroused should not be let lapse.

In such an undertaking it is not absolutely necessary

that such an organization as the American City Bureau be employed,

it only the club and citizens will do the work

without such leadership. The employment of the bureau

was the judgment of the officers and directors of the club

and they exercised that judgment in employing it

and starting the campaign. This did not meet with

the approval of some citizens and they very properly entered a protest

which was decided in their favor by a two-thirds majority

of citizens who had interest enough in the matter to attend

the mass meeting. Therefore the rescinding of the contract

with the bureau was proper.

It still remains to be demonstrated

whether those citizens who insisted on the bureau contract

being set aside, did so because they were utterly opposed

to such a movement as the club proposed for vitalizing and systematizing

the club work, to which they entered a disclaimer

at the meeting that acted on the matter, or whether they were

staunch friends of the project, as they asserted themselves to be,

but did not approve the methods employed by the club officers.
