Make 500,000 FORDS in Half Year
Company Expects to Make More Than One Million Yearly
When the first six months of the Ford Motor Company fiscal year ended January 31st, more than half a million of the sturdy little Fords had left the Factory to join their three and a half million brothers and sisters on the world's highways. And Ford officials express confidence in their ability to turn loose the other half of the million by July 31st, when their year ends.
However, they say that a million a year is far from the ultimate in motor car manufacturing; and that with the completion of the Blast Furnaces and Body Plants which Henry Ford is now building in Detroit, the yearly output capacity is bound to assume larger dimensions. The present capacity is 1,200,000.
The blast furnace project on which Mr. Ford has been working for the past three years will enable the Ford Company to make Ford parts direct from the iron ore instead of buying the iron ingots and then melting them before making into parts. At the present time there are approximately 15,000 men engaged at the blast furnaces and in the new body plant. But it is quite probable that the number will be more than doubled once the steel mills—which will be the largest in America—begin to operate. Ford men do not attempt to place any estimate on what the production of cars will be in the future, but point to the fact that they have not been able to supply the demand for the past ten years and that at the present time there are some 220,000 unfilled orders on file.
