secure copies of the Toveri. Both expressed their special desire to read the issues of the 15th and 20th inst., although they were not visiting together.

And there is something in them to read, too. The first-mentioned issue, for instance, contains accounts of the enormous profits of the Steel Trust and other corporations; of the advantages of feeding and rational education of children; of the overwhelming social privations that the workers suffer as a result of their supine voting for capitalist candidates and not making efforts to understand the importance of their organized mass action; miscarriages of justice; wicked, false peace propositions of the junker government of Germany; of the shipworkers' manly fight for their rights against unscrupulous exploiters, of the lies published by the local subsidized press about the strike situation and of many other important things. In the same issue, printed across the entire third page, there is to be found what the famous American statesman, Daniel Webster had to say on free speech: That "It is a right to be maintained in peace or war. It is a right that cannot be invaded without destroying constitutional liberty. Hence this right should be guarded and protected by the free men of this country with a zealous care, unless they are prepared for chains or anarchy." Oh, how vividly that brings to mind the section of the Constitution of the United States of America which reads: "Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion, or prohibiting free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances."

The other one of those issues is scarcely inferior. It should not be missing one's oil to read them, indeed. And it is no surprise that the Toveri arouses attention.
