The protected cruiser Boston has been turned over to the Oregon Naval Reserve for use in maneuvers and in perfecting the training of the volunteer sailors who make up the organization. The cruiser will first be put in good condition, several repairs being necessary to fit her for the purpose, and she will then be turned over to the Oregon Naval Reserve to be used as an annuity for the men and a training ship to teach naval service to those who have enlisted.

RIVERS AND HARBORS BILL PASSED BY HOUSE

Washington.—The house passed the rivers and harbors appropriation bill, carrying approximately \$31,000,000. Following are the principal appropriations for the Pacific coast:
Coos Bay, Ore., \$40,000; Columbia River, Celilo falls to Snake River, \$25,000; Dalles River to Celilo falls, \$500,000; lower Willamette River, \$150,000; mouth of Columbia River, \$50,000; Willamette above Portland, \$20,000; Grays Harbor, \$300,000; Puget Sound, \$20,000; Snohomish River, \$75,000.
In addition to the amount carried in this bill, the sundry civil bill will include \$7,368,077 for river and harbor improvements in 1912, bringing the total up to \$29,363,938.

Congressional News Bits.
Senator Taylor, of Tennessee, introduced a bill to extend the provisions of the national pure food law to tobacco in whatever form it may be offered for sale.
Senator Borah introduced bills appropriating \$200,000 for a public building at Twin Falls and \$150,000 for a site and building at Nampa.
The Ballinger-Pinchot reports will not be acted upon by the house committee on agriculture, to which they have been referred, until after the Christmas holidays, at least, and perhaps not at all, according to present indications.
The Republican Congressional committee received \$77,461 and disbursed \$74,273, while the Democratic Congressional committee received \$27,790 and disbursed \$27,771 during the recent campaign, according to reports filed with the clerk of the house of representatives.

Pendleton.—The old agency buildings which have stood for half a century or more, on the Umatilla Indian reservation and which have been going to pieces under the hands of vandals, were sold at auction by Major E. L. Swartzlander, and are to be torn down and moved away.
Among the buildings sold was the first church ever erected on the reservation. This was used for many years by the Catholics before the present Saint Andrews mission was established at its location near the foot of the mountains.
