70, or an average of \$327.17, which was \$75.94 a month more than in Union county.  
Union county is supposed to have more than twice the population and wealth of Wallowa.  
The total receipts in Clerk Boatman's office during the four months were as follows: August \$352.50,

September \$336.95, October \$424.75, November \$495.20; total \$1659.70, or an average of \$414.92 a month. The expense for salaries of the clerk and two deputies is \$225 a month.
