

Announce Tests in Egg Production. Corvallis-November 1 will see the completion of some valuable tests now being made at the Oregon Agricultural college by Professor James Dryden, poultry husbandman, which will prove the effect of crossing Barred Plymouth Rocks with White Leghorns to

increase egg production. By means of the trapnest which Professor Dryden originated some years ago and which is now in use at a number of experiment stations and poultry farms of the country, he has several hundred hens out of the college flock of 2,000 chickens making laying records. While some have have a record of less than a dozen eggs in a year others have hald more than 200 eggs annually.
