

New Manufacturing Industry.

North Bend at the present time supports several large manufacturing institutions, and several more are about to be established here.

There is every reason to expect that the population and the pay roll will be doubled within the next 12 months.

North Bend is destined to become one of the foremost manufacturing cities on the Pacific coast.

The Post has recently learned from a most reliable source that a company is shortly to be organized to manufacture brick in North Bend.

Hitherto the white scrub sand of the ocean beach has been considered of no value, but it has been left for a North Bend business man to discover that there is a great fortune in it.

Some years ago a machine and process was patented in Germany for manufacturing brick from sand mixed with lime, the process of which requires a tremendous steam pressure.

These sand brick contain 8 per cent lime. The agent of the company which manufactures the machinery necessary to produce the sand brick will install the machinery and thoroughly demonstrate its practicability and the excellence of its product before turning it over to the company.

The gentlemen who are interested in the venture do not care to have their names made public at this time, but just as soon as more definite arrangements have been made and the prospectus is prepared The Post will publish further information concerning the project.—North Bend Post.

Leading Events of Twentieth Week of the War.

June 23rd—Russian Port Arthur squadron, under Admiral Wittset, consisting of 6 battleships, 5 cruisers and 14 destroyers, makes an appearance at the entrance of the harbor.

Japanese torpedoboats, Nos. 53, 64 and 66 are also slightly damaged. The "Peresviet" is a battleship of the first class, 12,672 tons burden, with 4 10-inch, 11 6-inch, 16 3-inch, and 29 smaller guns and 5 torpedo tubes.

Marquis Oyama is appointed to supreme command of the Japanese forces in Manchuria with Lieutenant-General Kodama as his chief of staff.

June 24th.—St. Petersburg dispatch states the damage done upon the Japanese by the Vladivostok squadron as 1,000 men killed and captured.

Port Arthur is bombarded from land and sea for 12 hours. June 25th.—Russian Vladivostok squadron is reported to be out in the Korean waters again.

June 26th.—Japanese army under General Kuroki wins a decisive battle near Tashi Chao and forces the main Russian body to retreat to the north.

June 27th.—Japanese army investing Port Arthur from the land side defeats the Russians and captures three outer forts.

June 28th.—Japanese occupy Kaichow after a severe battle with the Russians. June 29th.—Generals Kuroki and Oku effect a junction of their two armies, and a battle with Kuropatkin is expected.
