Oregon Officials Well Paid.

Oregon pays secretary of state more than twice as much as is received by the secretary of state of the United States, twice as much as the salary of Governor Odell of New York and about four times the salary of United States senators and representatives.

Oregon's state treasurer makes at least twice as much as the vice-president or the members of the president's cabinet.

From a financial standpoint it is better to be United States ambassador and minister plenipotentiary at the court of St. James.

New York City, with a population eight times as great as that of the entire state of Oregon, and an assessed valuation forty times as great, pays her mayor less money than is made annually by either the secretary of state, the state treasurer or the state printer of Oregon.
