Unions

Six of the biggest trusts and corporations in the United States have most influenital bodies affiliated with the Federation of Labor.

The aggregate capitalization of the trusts is \$2,000,000,000, and their aim is to reduce wages, increase hours and re-arrange conditions so dividends can be paid.

The corporations named are the United Steel corporation, the International Harvesting Machine Company, the United States Rubber Company, the Glucose Sugar Company, the Pullman Company and the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific railroad. Incidents of lowered wages, increased hours and closed plants during the past year are cited as evidence of the war's beginning. Another feature of the trust plan is said to be a determination to employ no man more than thirty-five years of age.-Ex.


