caste person, however extreme
need; and a high caste doctor will
go to the bedside of a dying
Hindu. "Thanks be to God," said to

ple by the British government." A
Hindu will not deliver letters into
the hands of a lower caste man than
himself; he flings them down on the
ground. Democracy has no expres-
sion whatever in India except through
the British government, which devotes all its

Caste, you may be told, is breaking
down in the cities. This is partly true,
but only in a general sense. And if
caste broke down absolutely in all
the cities it would not alter the truth
of Sir Bamfield Fuller's statement.
For the cities are only specks on the
map of India and the people who dwell
there are not a child's handful out
of the 300,000,000 inhabitants. Some-
thing like 90 per cent. of the popula-
tion live on the land, and among these
270,000,000 the system of caste is not
merely lieutenant governor or vice-
roy, but king of India, the one su-
preme and unquestioning obedience is
rendered by all the peoples.

Fumigating the Sick Room.
Close doors and windows and remove everything removable.
Use either sulphur candles or pieces of chloride of lime. The fumes of sulphur are poisonous, so see that the children are removed to a place of safety.
In serious diseases use formaldehyde.
Caring for the walls, scrubbing the floors with hot soapuds and a strong solution of carbolic acid is important. The carpets must be sent to cleaners to be cleaned thoroughly at home.
Curtains should be washed and dried.
