FARMER CANDIDATE GIVES HIS PLATFORM

H. C. Wheeler of Pleasant Hill in announcing his candidacy for the lower house submits the following platform: "Believing that the only way to lighten the burden of taxation in the state and county is to reduce the expenditures of the public money to the lowest possible minimum, consistent with good government, I favor:

"The repeal of all unnecessary commissions and the discontinuation of all superfluous superintendents, deputies and clerks.

"The enactment of a law prohibiting county officials and their deputies from dealing either directly or indirectly in county warrants or claims against the county other than such as may be originally their own.

"The repeal of our present law pertaining to the collection of taxes and the substitution thereof of one providing for semi-annual payments, one-half to be paid in the spring and the other in the fall with no rebate penalty or interest if so paid.

"The repeal of all unnecessary and useless laws and the strict enforcement of law and order.

"I also believe that the voters of the county should make a thorough investigation regarding each candidate and determine whether his past record corresponds to his campaign promises."

Mr. Wheeler is a successful farmer, is a member of Pleasant Hill Grange, is a director of Union High School District No. 1, having been twice elected to that position, and has served fifteen years as clerk of Trent School District No. 3. He has just completed his tenth year as clerk of Pleasant Hill Camp No. 271, Woodmen of the World.

SPRINGFIELD CANDIDATE IS FOR PROHIBITION

Rev. James T. Moore of Springfield, former pastor of the Methodist Church of this city, is deeply interested in the candidacy of Melvin Fenwick of Springfield for the lower house of the legislature. He is writing strong letters of endorsement to his Cottage Grove friends.

Mr. Fenwick's platform is as follows: "I advocate the lowest rate of taxation possible consistent with good government, taxes to be paid in two semi-annual payments without rebate. "Cutting out all useless commissions and consolidating all the necessary ones in some form to make them effective at the lowest possible cost to the taxpayers.

"Good roads, but no graft in their construction.

"Positively no saloons under any conditions, and advancement of education in all lines."

The people of Pleasant Hill last week added to their reputation as true friends in need when a number, equal to that which the week before plowed and seeded Mrs. Ollie Williams' 40 acres, swept down on the 75-acre farm of Mrs. W. F. Webb and plowed, disked, harrowed and seeded it and ricked up several cords of wood.
