BROTHER KILLED IN WAR

G. H. and A. H. Tyson Get News of Death of Lieut. Tyson

G. H. Tyson, of the Hampton store in Eugene, and A. H. Tyson, a farmer living near Santa Clara, received a letter Thursday telling them of the death of their brother, Lieutenant Jack Tyson, during the British and French drive against the Germans on September 26.

Lieutenant Tyson was an officer in the third Gurkha regiment from India, and had been in service only a year. He was a tea planter in India, where he had lived all his life, and volunteered soon after the war began to serve his country, having been given a letter of commendation from the start. He was aged 41 and married only last April. He was wounded in one hand last August but was off duty only a short time on account of the wound.

Lieutenant Tyson was killed by a German bullet in the capture of Loos by the British. His regiment made a very brilliant charge on the German trenches, and many of the officers and men were killed.
