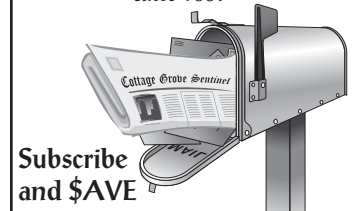
She was loved by all and will truly be missed.
